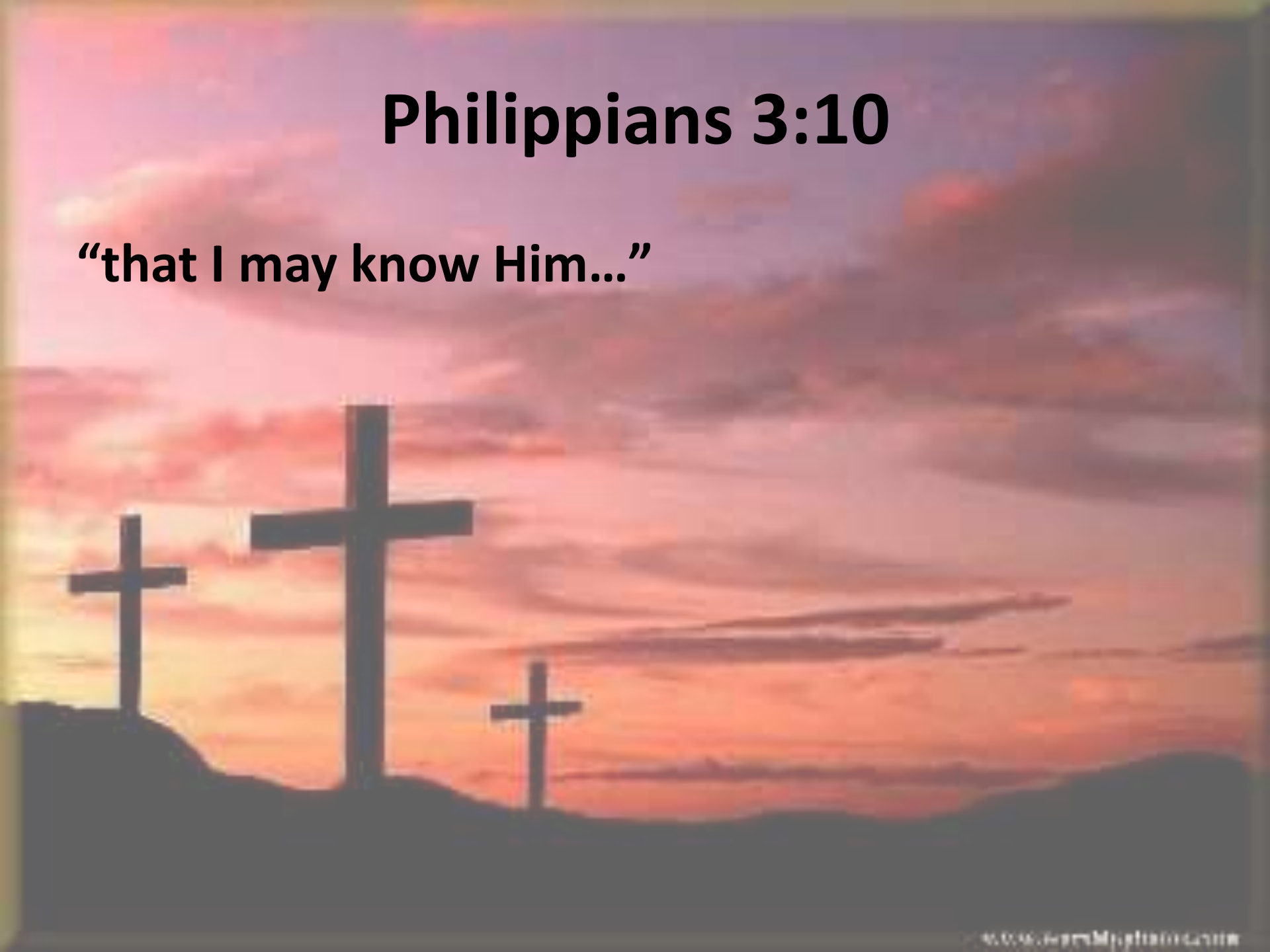

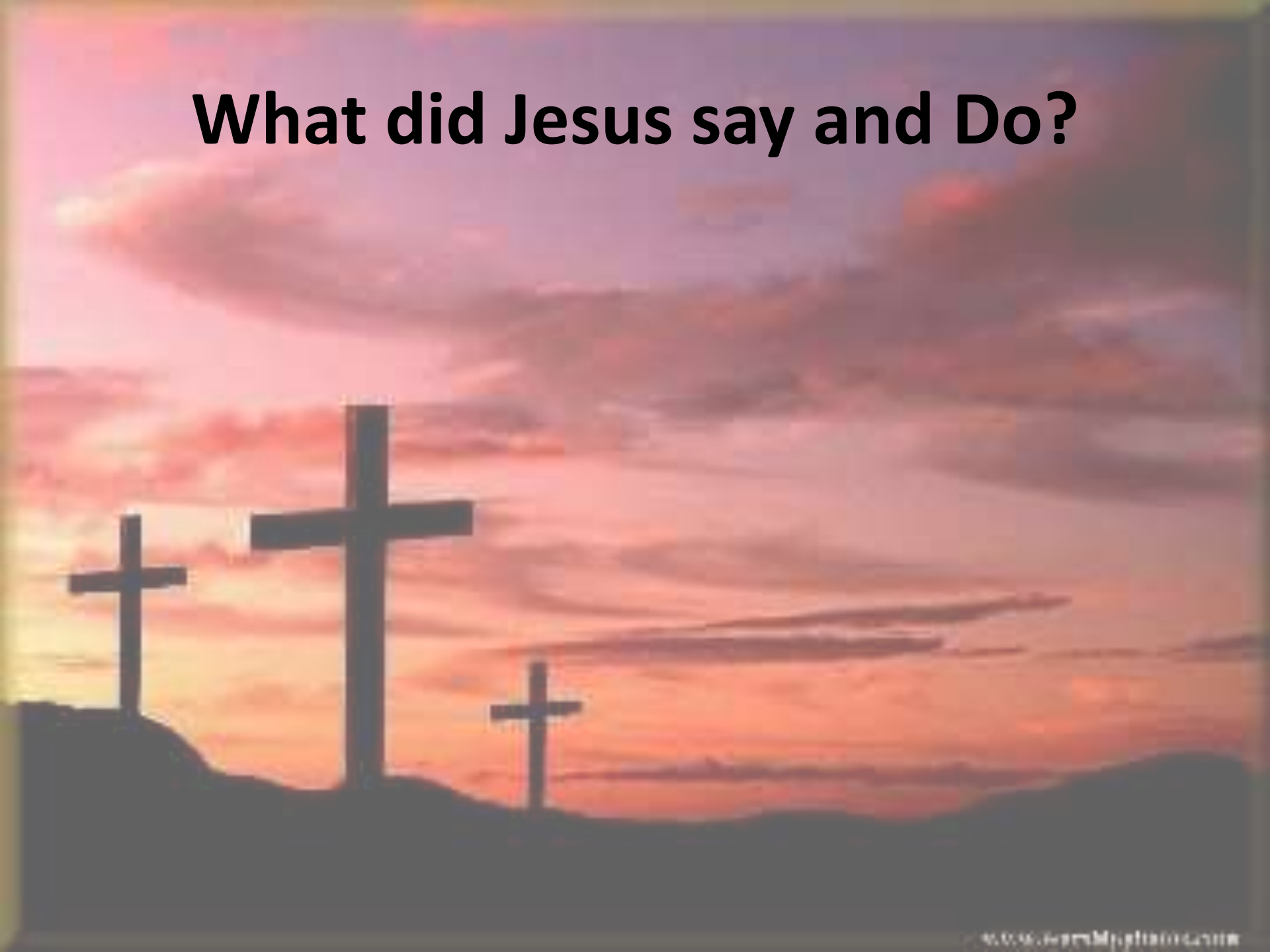

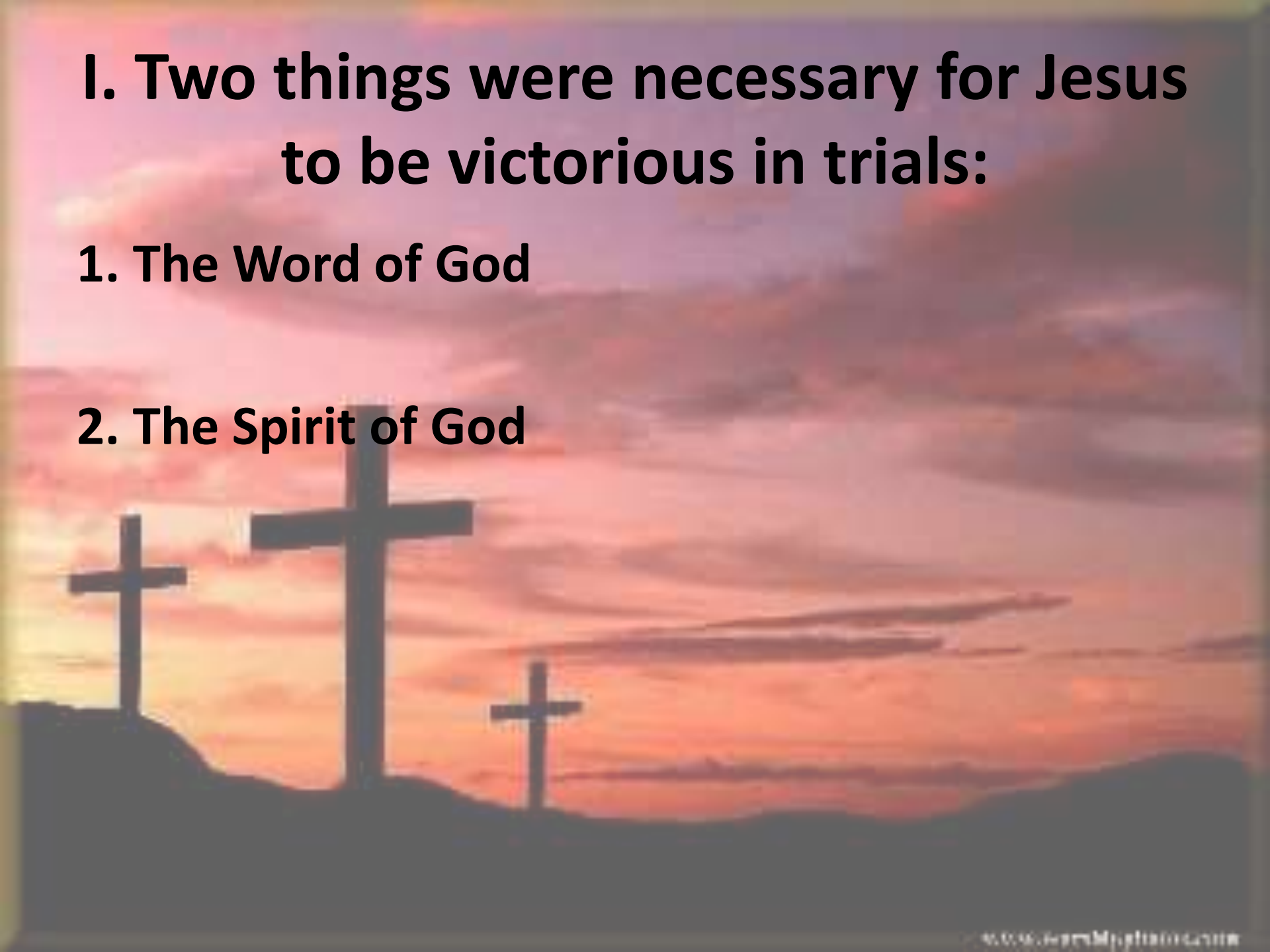

# **I. Two things were necessary for Jesus to be victorious in trials:**

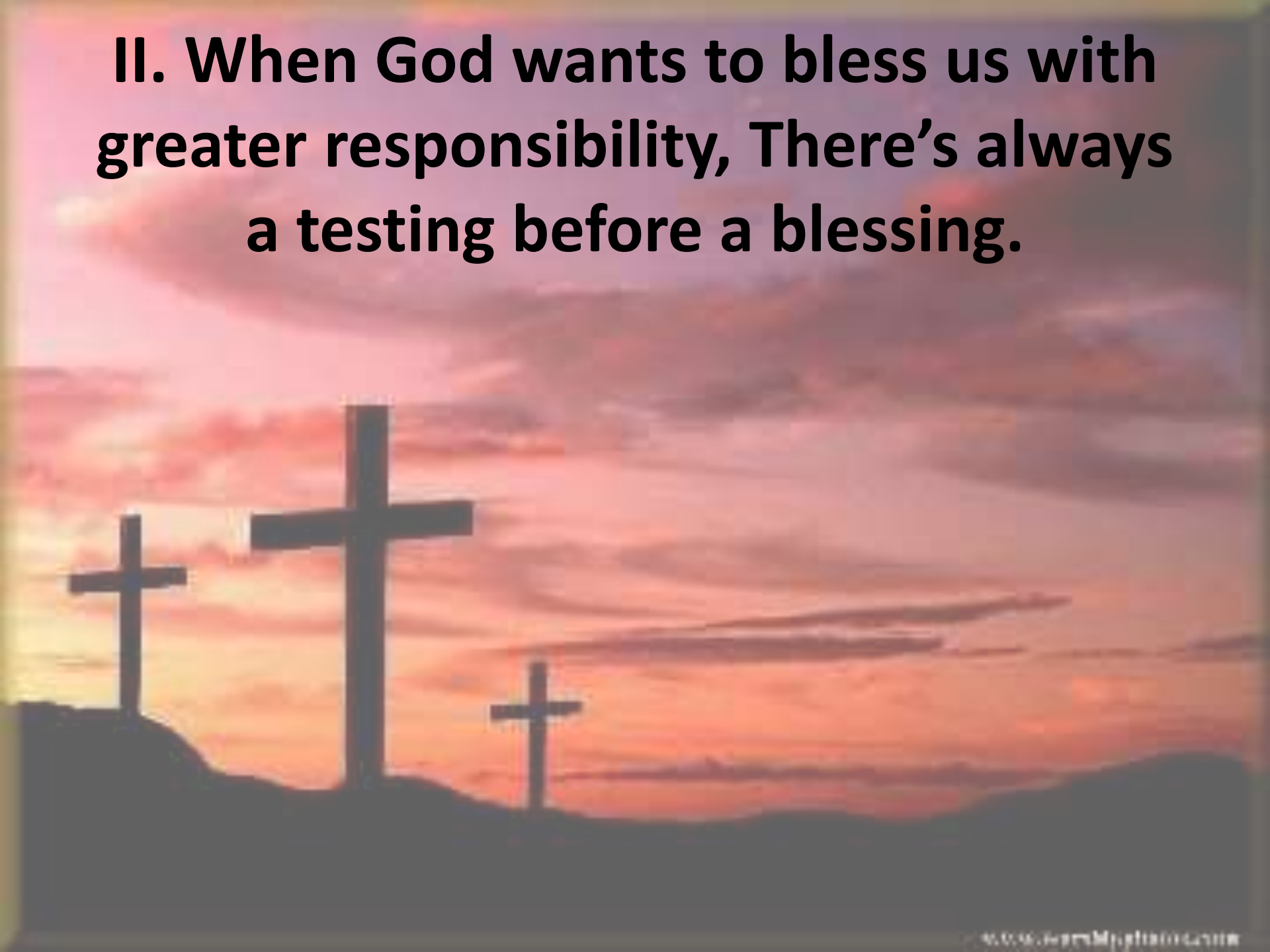
**1. The Word of God**

**2. The Spirit of God**

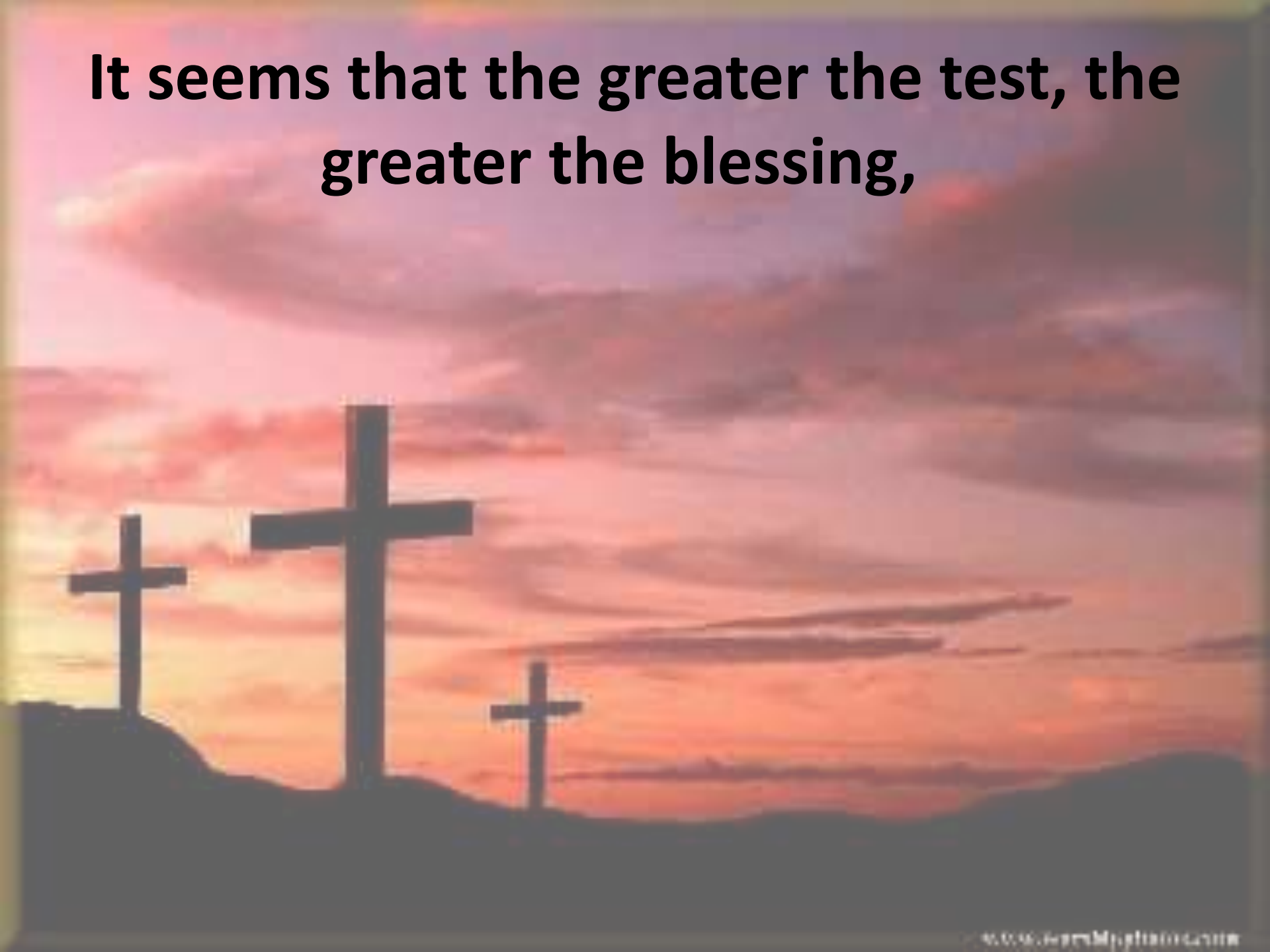




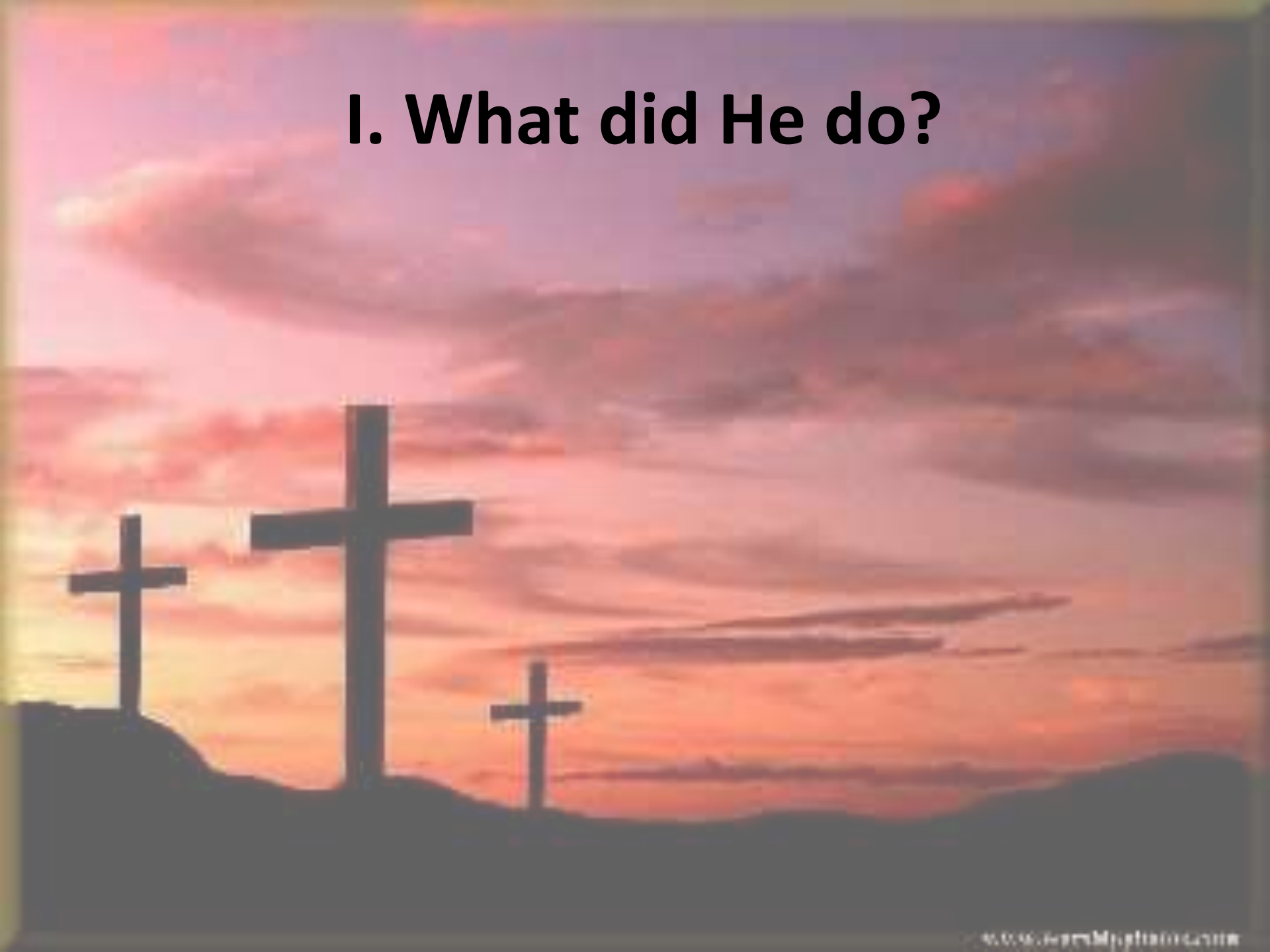
**II. When God wants to bless us with greater responsibility, There's always a testing before a blessing.**

# I. What did He do?






**A. Jesus resisted every temptation.**

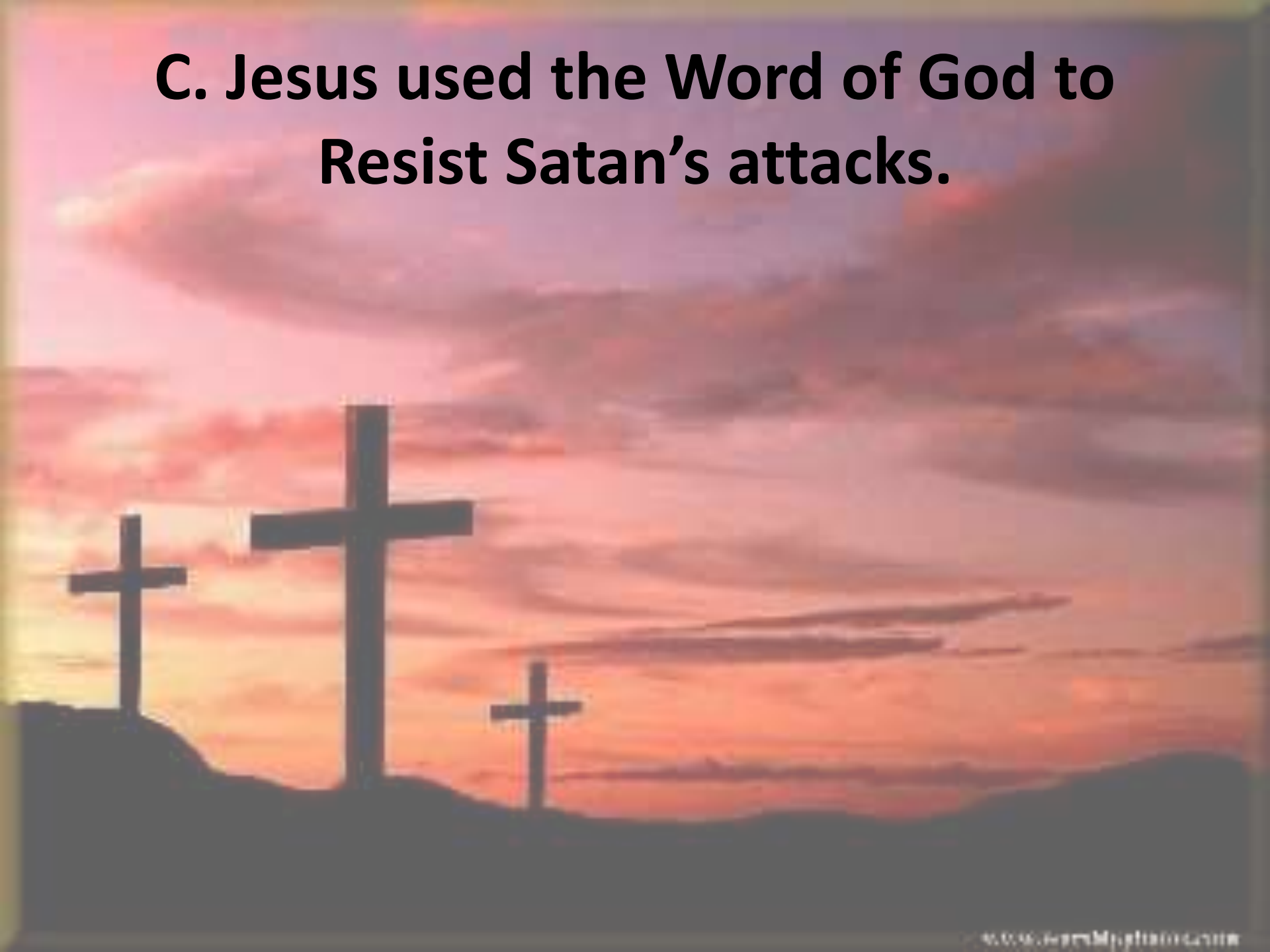

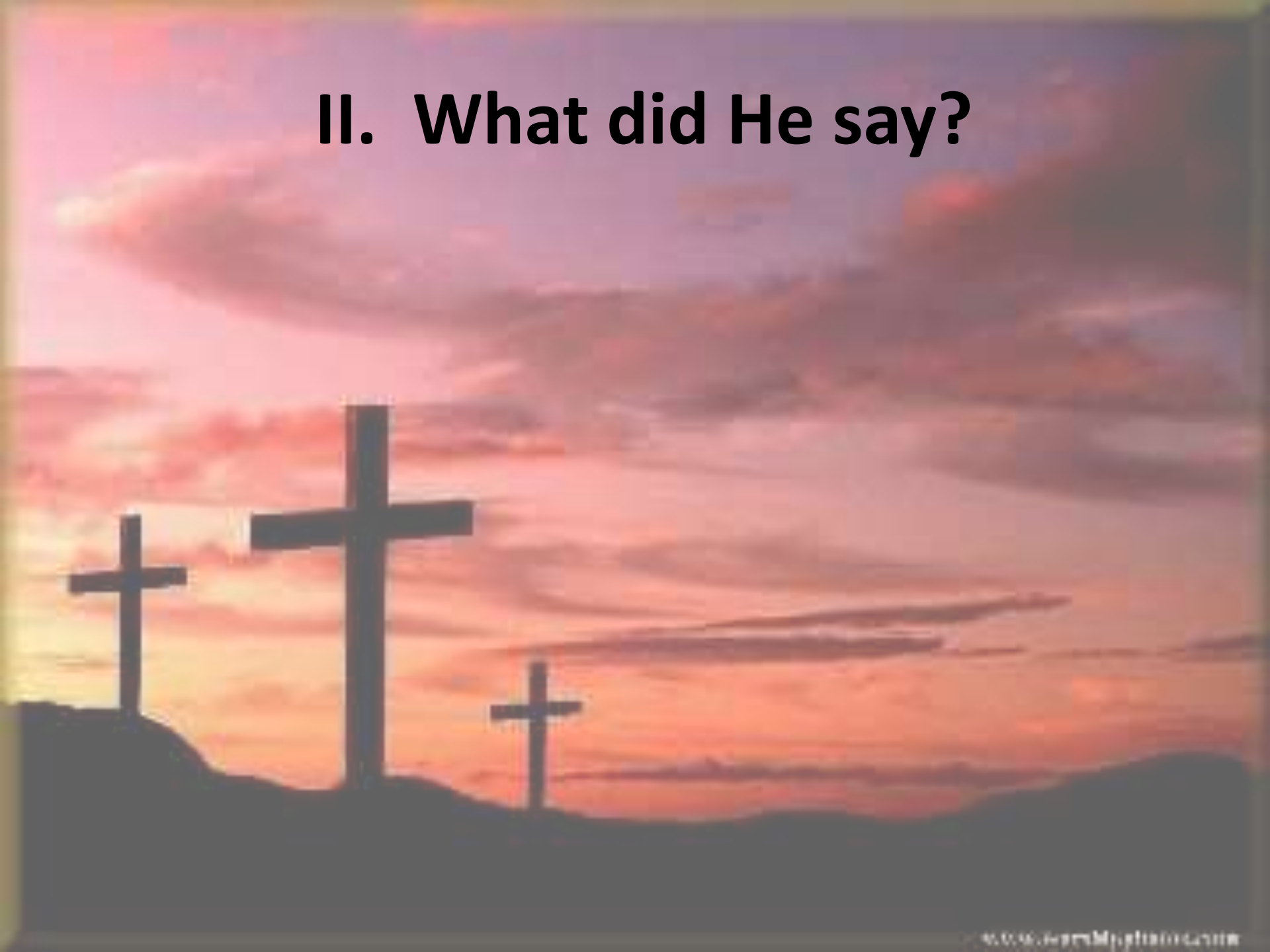

# Deuteronomy 6:16 (NKJV)

**16 "You shall not tempt the LORD your God as you tempted *Him* in Massah. (At Massah the children of Israel were complaining because there wasn't any water.)**

# Exodus 17:1-7 (NKJV)

**<sup>2</sup> Therefore the people contended with Moses, and said, "Give us water, that we may drink." And Moses said to them, "Why do you contend with me? Why do you tempt the LORD?"**

**<sup>7</sup> So he called the name of the place Massah and Meribah, because of the contention of the children of Israel, and because they tempted the LORD, saying, "Is the LORD among us or not?"**
