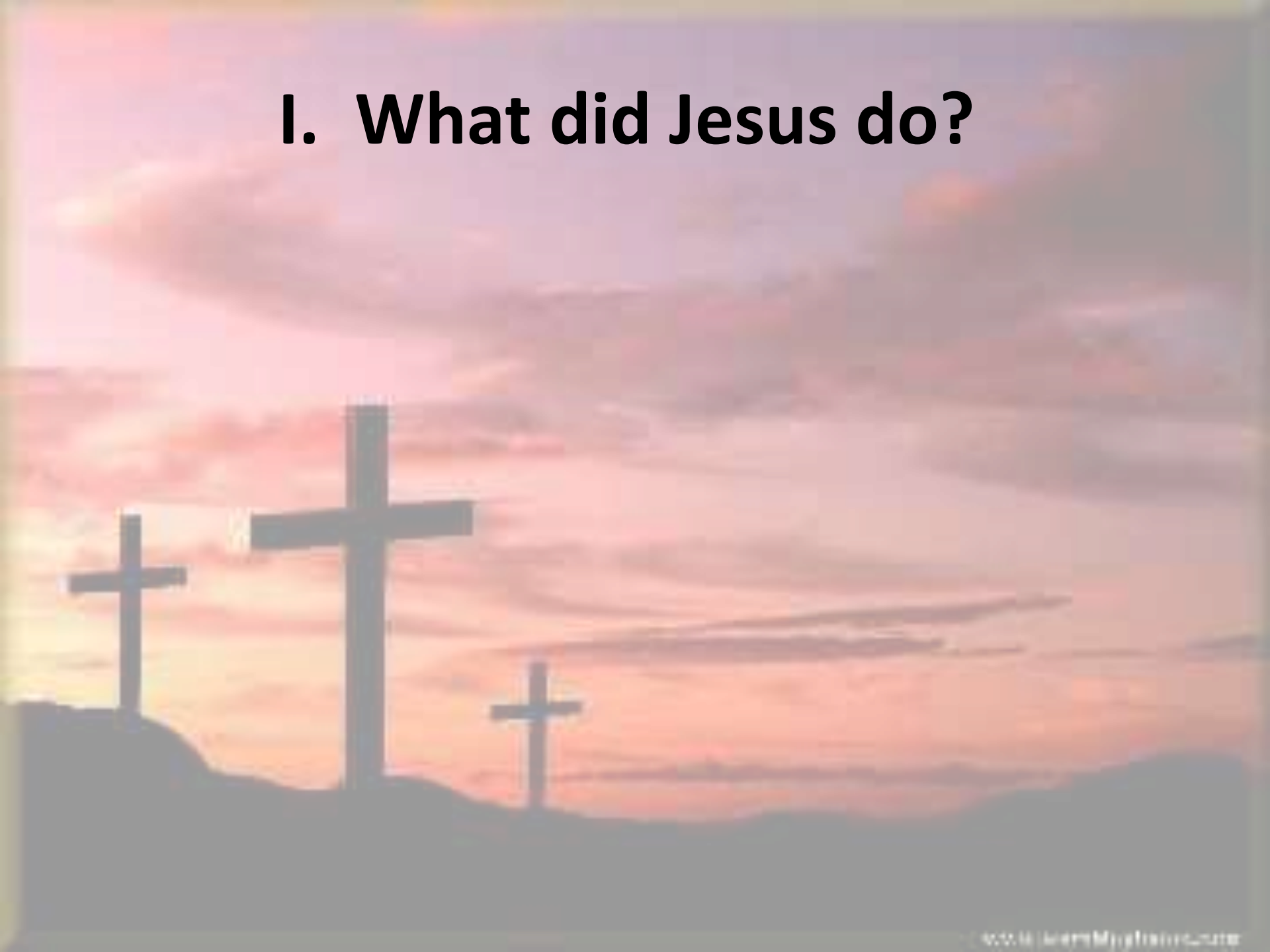

19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD."

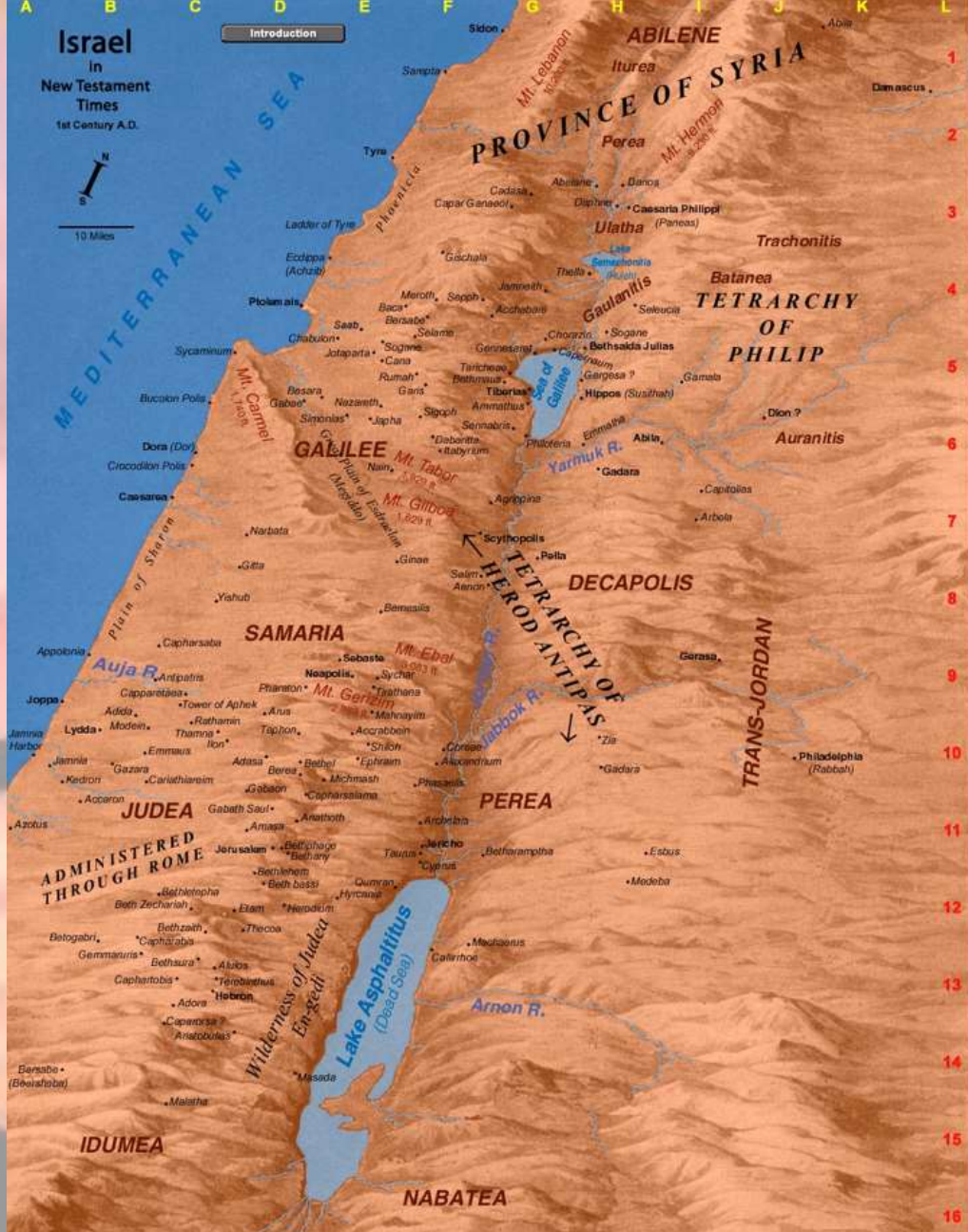
20 Then He closed the book, and gave *it* back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him.

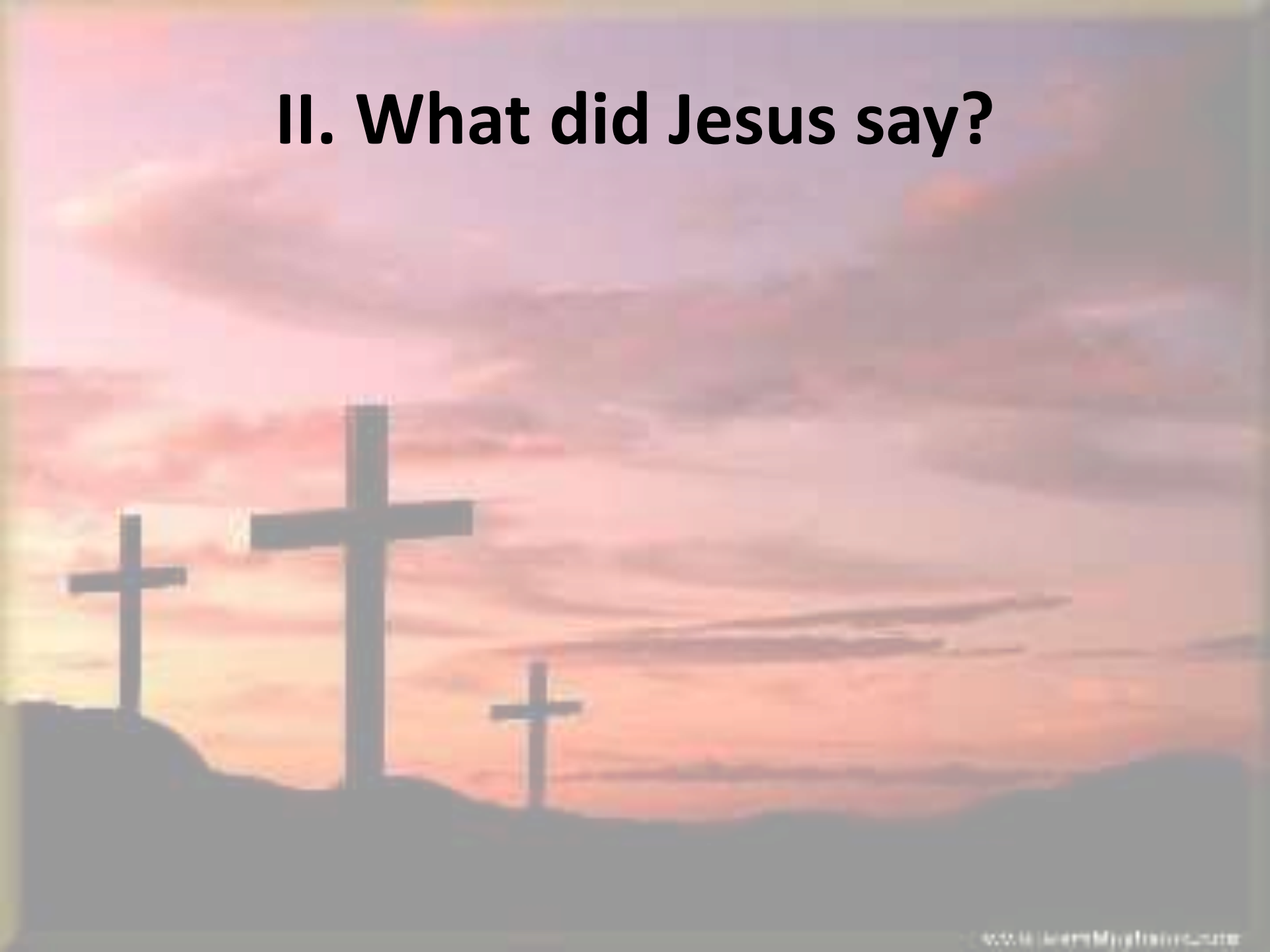

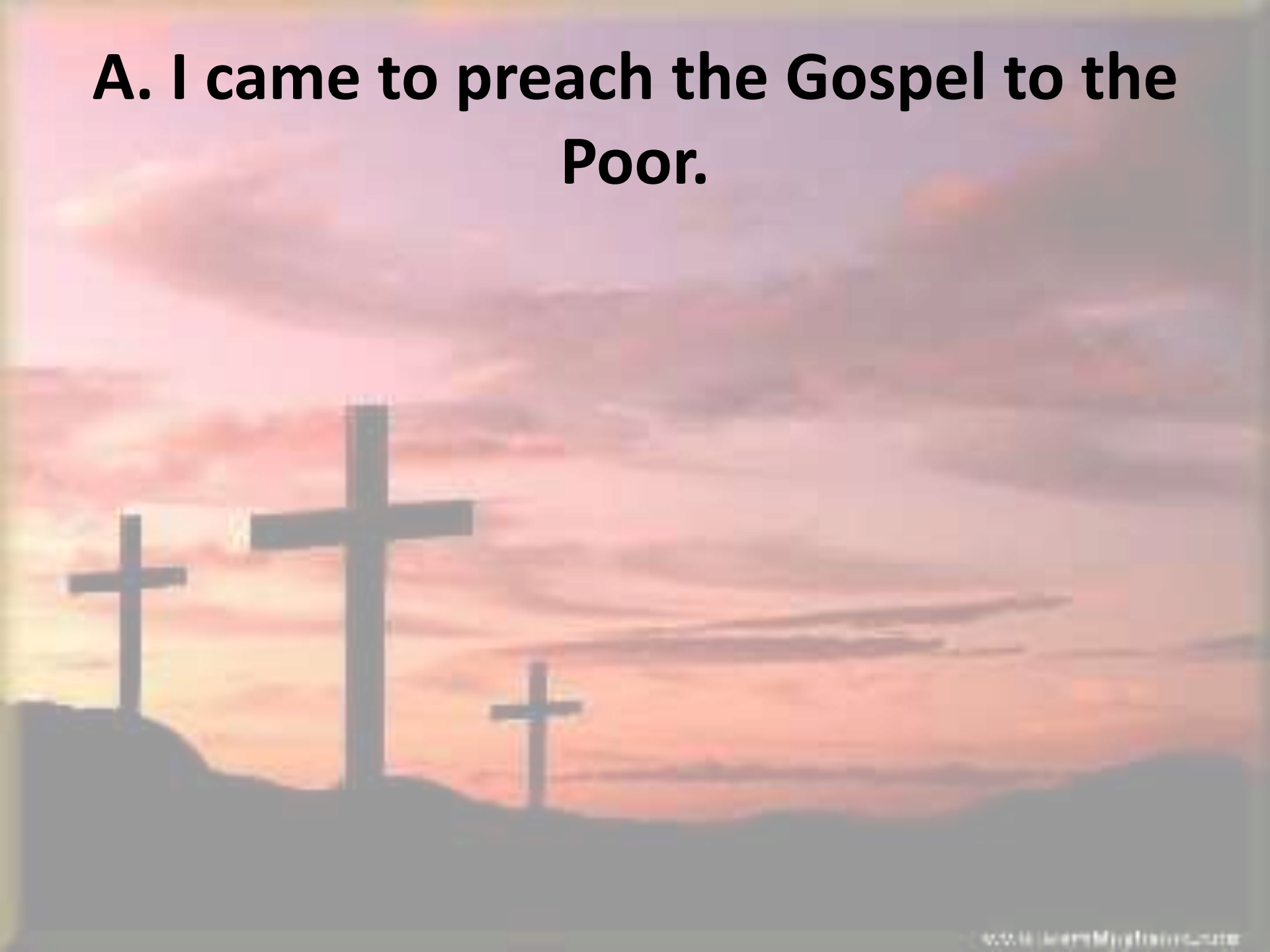

**A. I came to preach the Gospel to the
Poor.**



B. I came to Heal the brokenhearted.



Isaiah 61:1 (NKJV)

**1 "The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon Me,
Because the LORD has anointed Me To preach
good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to
heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to
the captives, And the opening of the prison to
*those who are bound;***

Isaiah 61:2-3 (NKJV)

² To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD and the day of vengeance of our God; To comfort all who mourn,

³ To console those who mourn in Zion, To give them beauty for ashes, The oil of joy for mourning, The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; That they may be called trees of righteousness, The planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified."

Receive Healing and Restoration

Tell the Lord you have a broken heart.

Tell Him why.

Remember the pain. Embrace the pain. This is healing pain.

Tell Jesus everything. Trust Him with the pain.

Release it to Him

Receive healing and restoration

This may be a Process. Seek help if you need.

**C. I came to bring recovery of sight to
the blind.**



Acts 26:17-18 (NKJV)

17 I will deliver you from the *Jewish* people, as well as *from* the Gentiles, to whom I now send you,

18 to open their eyes, *in order* to turn *them* from darkness to light, and *from* the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.'

D. Set the captives free. Last week we shared that whom Jesus sets free they are free indeed.
