



HEBREWS 9:1-14

THE TABERNACLE OF MOSES



EXODUS 29:42-46 (NLT)

- 42** “These burnt offerings are to be made each day from generation to generation. Offer them in the LORD’s presence at the Tabernacle entrance; there I will meet with you and speak with you.
- 43** I will meet the people of Israel there, in the place made holy by my glorious presence.
- 44** Yes, I will consecrate the Tabernacle and the altar, and I will consecrate Aaron and his sons to serve me as priests.

EXODUS 29:42-46 (NLT)

45 Then I will live among the people of Israel and be their God,

46 and they will know that I am the LORD their God. I am the one who brought them out of the land of Egypt so that I could live among them. I am the LORD their God.

THE TABERNACLE IN HEAVEN

ROMANS 8:35-39 (NLT)

- 35** Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death?
- 36** (As the Scriptures say, "For your sake we are killed every day; we are being slaughtered like sheep.")
- 37** No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.

ROMANS 8:35-39 (NLT)

- 38** And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love.
- 39** No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.

REVELATION 3:15-20 (NLT)

- 15** “I know all the things you do, that you are neither hot nor cold. I wish that you were one or the other!
- 16** But since you are like lukewarm water, neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth!
- 17** You say, ‘I am rich. I have everything I want. I don’t need a thing!’ And you don’t realize that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked.

REVELATION 3:15-20 (NLT)

- 18** So I advise you to buy gold from me—gold that has been purified by fire. Then you will be rich. Also buy white garments from me so you will not be shamed by your nakedness, and ointment for your eyes so you will be able to see.
- 19** I correct and discipline everyone I love. So be diligent and turn from your indifference.
- 20** “Look! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in, and we will share a meal together as friends.
