
***Hebrews 11:6 (NLT2)***

by all.**




***Psalm 95:7-8 (NKJV)***


*<sup>7</sup> For He is our God, And we are the people of His pasture, And the sheep of His hand. Today, if you will hear His voice:*

**Exodus 17:1-7**




*<sup>1</sup> Then all the congregation of the sons of Israel journeyed by stages from the wilderness of Sin, according to the command of the LORD, and camped at Rephidim, and there was no water for the people to drink. <sup>2</sup> Therefore the people quarreled with Moses and said, "Give us water that we may drink." And Moses said to them, "Why do you quarrel with me? Why do you test the LORD?"*
