Sometimes in selfishness a mother forgets her child.


God never forgets because He is perfect.

Engrave is the Hebrew word chaqqaq(khaw-kak) and it means to cut in or inscribe. Part of its usage is from scribes of old carving into tablets of stone, or metal. From Strong's Exhaustive Concordance-A primitive root; properly to hack, i.e. engrave; by implication to enact(laws being cut in stone or metal tablets in primitive times).

John 10:27-30 “My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me, and I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of My hand. My Father, Who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father’s hand. I and the Father are one.”


