
Never Miss An Opportunity To Love Someone

We must deny ourselves self daily!!!!!


Luke 9:23


"Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning." (James 1:17)

When I sweep my floor all that I have done is sweep my floor. But, when I sweep your floor I have helped you.





We were created for fellowship with Him-Prayer, Scripture, Worship.




