- a. I hear voices in my head
- b.I have nightmares and/or night terrors almost nightly.
- c. I have so much rage I black out and am unable to remember what I did.

- d. I have uncontrollable fear.
- e. I have a problem with self-harm cutting myself, overwhelming thoughts of suicide.
- f. I have an overpowering desire to hurt someone else or kill someone.

g. I have demonic sexual dreams. (Incubus – Succubus)

h. I have drug dreams.

- i. I hear noises no one else hears, see demons no one else sees (?)
- j. Many diseases are caused by the demonic.

Luke 13:10-13 (NKJV)

- ¹⁰ Now He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath.
- And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise herself up.

- ¹² But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, "Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity."
- ¹³ And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

5. Finding the Entry (Three ways)

a. Ask Holy Spirit

Jeremiah 33:3 (NKJV)

³ 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'

6. 7 Steps to Removing the enemy and Releasing Sanctification

The captive:

- a. Confesses the sin that allowed entry
- b. Repents for the sin that allowed entry, thereby cancelling the legal right of the enemy to reside there.



- c. Forgives any/all who perpetuated the event that incited the captive to open the door.
- d. Renounces the action and the spirit/demon

The captive:

e. Removes the demon/spirit by commanding it to leave in the name of Jesus. (It may be necessary for the deliverance minister to administer this directive.)



- f. Fills voids with Holy Spirit by praying for the fruit which is opposite of what has been evicted.
- g. Fills voids left by the enemy with Bible Study and memory verses addressing the weak area.

* They must become involved in a Christ centered fellowship where others can be an encouragement to them.

* They need to connect through prayer with Father and Holy Spirit every day.

2 Corinthians 10:3-6 (NKJV)

- ³ For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh.
