Matthew 9:35-38 (NKJV)

³⁵ Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. ³⁶ But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.

³⁷ Then He said to His disciples, “The harvest truly *is* plentiful, but the laborers *are* few. ³⁸ Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.”

*Those who don't know Jesus are dead.

Ephesians 2:1 (NKJV)

II. Give me a heart to love the lost.

Four Words translated Hell

1. Sheol
2. Hades
3. Gehenna
4. Torturous

Four Words translated Hell

Sheol – The abode of the dead in early Hebrew thought. (Mirriam Webster)

Sometimes translated – the grave.

1 Co 15:20–23 (NKJV) ²⁰ But now Christ is risen from the dead, *and* has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. ²¹ For since by man *came* death, by Man also *came* the resurrection of the dead. ²² For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. ²³ But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those *who are* Christ's at His coming.

Eph. 4:7-10 (NKJV)

⁷ But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift. ⁸ Therefore He says:

*“When He ascended on high,
He led captivity captive,
And gave gifts to men.”*

⁹ (Now this, “*He ascended*”—what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? ¹⁰ He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)

Four Words translated Hell

Hades – Greek Word corresponding with the Hebrew Word Sheol. Same idea.

Sometimes translated – the grave.

Four Words translated Hell

“Tartarus” occurs only in 2 Peter 2:4

4 For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast *them down to hell (tartarus) and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment; (NKJV)*

Four Words translated Hell

4. Gehenna – Jesus referenced this place as the place where those who are separated from Him go into the afterlife.

³¹ And they have built the high places of Tophet, which *is* in the Valley of the Son of Hinnom, to burn their sons and their daughters in the fire, which I did not command, nor did it come into My heart.

Jer. 7:30-31 (NKJV)

³⁴ But they set their abominations in the house which is called by My name, to defile it. ³⁵ And they built the high places of Baal which *are* in the Valley of the Son of Hinnom, to cause their sons and their daughters to pass through *the fire* to Molech, which I did not command them, nor did it come into My mind that they should do this abomination, to cause Judah to sin.'

Jer. 32:33-35 (NKJV)

Is 30:33 (NKJV)

For Tophet *was* established of old,

Yes, for the king it is prepared.

He has made *it* deep and large;

Its pyre *is* fire with much wood;

The breath of the LORD, like a stream of
brimstone,

Kindles it.

Is. 66:24 (NKJV)

²⁴ “And they shall go forth and look
Upon the corpses of the men
Who have transgressed against Me.
For their worm does not die,
And their fire is not quenched.
They shall be an abhorrence to all flesh.”
