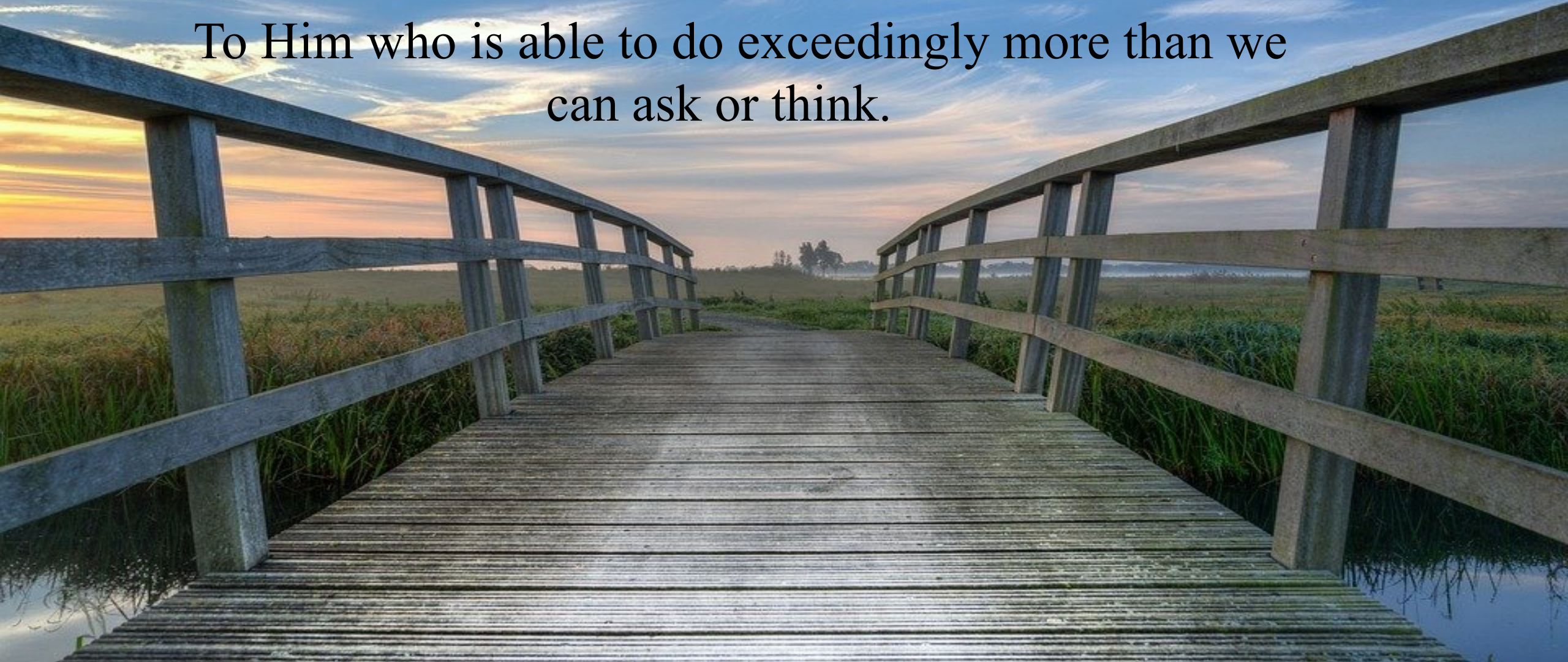


Now to Him who is able to do more than we ask.
