Genesis 5:23-24 (NLT2) <sup>23</sup> Enoch lived 365 years, <sup>24</sup> walking in close fellowship with God. Then one day he disappeared, because God took him. Hebrews 11:5-6 (NLT2) <sup>5</sup> It was by faith that Enoch was taken up to heaven without dying—"he disappeared, because God took him." For before he was taken up, <u>he was known as a person who pleased God.</u> Hebrews 11:6 (NLT2)

<sup>6</sup> And it is <u>impossible to please God without faith</u>. Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him.

### Proverbs 8:17 (NASB)

<sup>17</sup> "I love those who love me; And those who diligently seek me will find me.

## Ephesians 1:9-11 (NLT2)

<sup>9</sup> God has now revealed to us his mysterious plan regarding Christ, a plan to fulfill his own <u>good pleasure</u>. <sup>10</sup> And this is the plan: At the right time he will bring everything together under the authority of Christ—everything in heaven and on earth. <sup>11</sup> Furthermore, because we are united with Christ, we have received an inheritance from God, for he chose us in advance, and he makes everything work out according to his plan.

## 2. It pleased God greatly to put in place the mysterious plan of Christ being our Redeemer.

#### Acts 3:19-20 (NLT2)

<sup>19</sup> Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away.
<sup>20</sup> Then times of refreshment will come from the presence of the Lord, and he will again send you Jesus, your appointed Messiah.

## **Romans 10:9-13 (NLT2)**

<sup>9</sup> If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved. <sup>11</sup> As the Scriptures tell us, "Anyone who trusts in him will never be disgraced."
