*1 John 4:18*

*There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love.*





## **Philippians 4:5-7 (NASB)**

<sup>5</sup> ...The Lord is near. <sup>6</sup> Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

*<sup>21</sup> and be subject to one another in the fear of Christ.*

### ***1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 (NKJV)***

*<sup>16</sup> Rejoice always, <sup>17</sup> pray without ceasing,  
<sup>18</sup> in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus  
for you.*



## 2. Thank Him for the problem.

### ***James 1:1-4 (ESV)***

*<sup>1</sup> James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, To the twelve tribes in the Dispersion: Greetings. <sup>2</sup> Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds,*



## 2. Thank Him for the problem.

<sup>3</sup> *for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness.*

<sup>4</sup> *And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.*

*<sup>3</sup> His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence,*



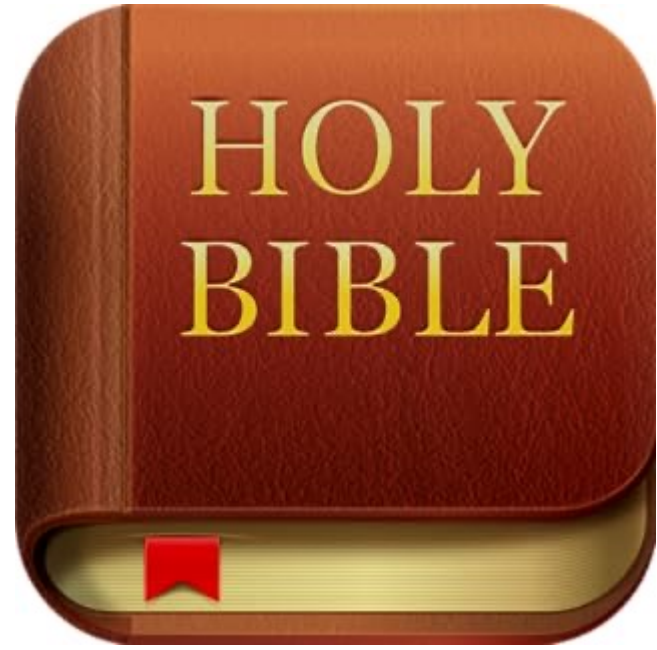
