


### Higher Marriage Counseling

#### John 17:20-23 (KJV)


- <sup>20</sup> Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;
- <sup>21</sup> That they all may be one; as thou, Father, *art* in me, and I in thee, that they also may
- be one in us: that the world may believe
- that thou hast sent me.
- <sup>22</sup> And the glory which thou gavest me I
- have given them; that they may be one,
- even as we are one:

<sup>23</sup> I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.

# 1 Corinthians 6:16-19 (KJV)

- <sup>16</sup> What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh.
- <sup>17</sup> But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.
- <sup>18</sup> Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.
  <sup>19</sup> What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?

### BEING IN THE LORD Colossians 3:1-4 (KJV)

- <sup>1</sup> If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those
- things which are above, where Christ
- sitteth on the right hand of God.
- <sup>2</sup> Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.
- <sup>3</sup> For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.
- <sup>4</sup> When Christ, *who is* our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.

Ephesians 4:22-24 (KJV) <sup>22</sup> That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; <sup>23</sup> And be renewed in the spirit of your

mind;

<sup>24</sup> And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. 2 Corinthians 5:17 (KJV) <sup>17</sup> Therefore if any man *be* in Christ, *he is* a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

### Jeremiah 31:31-33 (KJV)

- <sup>31</sup> Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:
- <sup>32</sup> Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD:

<sup>33</sup> But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

### Isaiah 54:5 (KJV)

<sup>5</sup> For thy Maker *is* thine husband; the LORD of hosts *is* his name; and thy Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; The God of the whole earth shall he be called.

## Mark 2:18-20 (KJV)

- <sup>18</sup> And the disciples of John and of the Pharisees used to fast: and they come and say unto him, Why do the disciples of John and of the Pharisees fast, but thy disciples fast not?
- <sup>19</sup> And Jesus said unto them, Can the children of the bridechamber fast, while the bridegroom is with them? as long as they have the bridegroom with them, they cannot fast.

<sup>20</sup> But the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken away from them, and then shall they fast in those days.

#### 2 Corinthians 11:2 (KJV)

<sup>2</sup> For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present *you as* a chaste virgin to Christ. <u>Successful Marriage</u> Communication – listening Committed – Devotion Intimacy – openness

Ephesians 5:22-33 (KJV) <sup>22</sup> Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. <sup>23</sup> For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

<sup>24</sup> Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so *let* the wives *be* to their own husbands in every thing. <sup>25</sup> Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

<sup>26</sup> That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

<sup>27</sup> That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

<sup>28</sup> So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself.

<sup>29</sup> For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church:

<sup>30</sup> For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones.

<sup>31</sup> For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined

unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh.

<sup>32</sup> This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church. <sup>33</sup> Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband.

1 Corinthians 11:1 (HCSB)
<sup>1</sup> Imitate me, as I also imitate Christ.

John 14:15 (HCSB) <sup>15</sup> "If you love Me, you will keep My commands.

## John 14:19-21 (KJV)

- <sup>19</sup> Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also.
- <sup>20</sup> At that day ye shall know that I *am* in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.
- <sup>21</sup> He that hath my commandments, and
- keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

Philippians 2:6-7 (KJV) <sup>6</sup> Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

<sup>7</sup> But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

### John 13:12-15 (HCSB)

<sup>12</sup> When Jesus had washed their feet and put on His robe, He reclined again and said to them, "Do you know what I have done for you?
<sup>13</sup> You call Me Teacher and Lord. This is well said, for I am.

<sup>14</sup> So if I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.

<sup>15</sup> For I have given you an example that you also should do just as I have done for you.
